Awareness and Respect

WIBA is structured to integrate Non-Profits with the business world and the world of our residents. The work that is done to help those that need it is often not known by enough people, and is absolutely underappreciated.

Approved Non-Profits enjoy listings and landing pages describing the work they do, with links to websites and Facebook. Being a member of our Alliance elevates awareness. A Non-Profit appearing on a site that recognizes their value will enjoy a more visible position in the City of Wyandotte.

Constant Contributions

One of WIBA's legs is **non-profit organizations** that provide various vital roles in the City of Wyandotte. A portion of all fees collected (including fees paid into WIBA by non-profits themselves) is channeled into a highly visible fund (page one of the website). These funds are distributed back to the participating non-profits on a quarterly basis as donations from the Wyandotte Independent Business Alliance (WIBA is also a non-profit, but is excluded from this sharing). The amounts dispersed will be publicly disclosed, and the visible meter on our website reset as we start over again. In joining forces with Love Wyandotte, a non-profit organization, you are automatically participating in active and ongoing support for these incredibly vital members of our community.

Leadership
